

Randall Rules and Regulations For Home Basketball Games

1. Fifth through eighth graders may attend the basketball games if they return a permission slip stating that they may stay and will be picked up at 6:15 P.M.
(Must have a permission slip for EACH game and they must be turned in by 2:45 p.m. on game day. NO CALLING HOME IF SLIPS ARE FORGOTTEN!)
2. No Phone Calls requesting a ride home will be permitted.
3. A student not picked up by 6:30 P.M. will not be allowed to attend the next game.
4. Students below fifth grade may stay or return to the basketball game if they are under the supervision of an adult, not a sibling in grades 5-8.
5. Teachers should not allow students to stay if they have incomplete work.
6. During the game, students must stay in the gym. Students may leave the gym only at half time of the B game, between the A and B games, and at halftime of the A game. This is a Westosha Conference Rule. Students are requested to use the restrooms outside the junior high office.
7. Good sportsmanship is a characteristic of Randall School students and we are proud of this. We must continue to be good sports by maintaining silence during free throws. Booing and whistling are not acceptable behavior at games.
8. In the interest of spectator safety, running will not be permitted.
9. Students will show courtesy and respect for chaperones and other adults. Your behavior will determine whether you will be allowed to attend any other game(s).
10. Students choosing not to follow the rules will be asked to leave immediately.
11. If a student goes home on the bus and wants to return to the school for the game, they must be accompanied by a parent/guardian OR bring a permission slip to the game and present it to the teachers/chaperones in charge at that game if the parent/guardian cannot stay. All of the rules stated above still apply.
12. PEP BAND MEMBERS: If you are not staying for the "A" Game, your pickup time is 5:30 p.m. If you stay for the game, pickup is at 6:15 p.m.

Any student in 4th grade or below must be accompanied to the games by their parent/guardian.
